**COTTER, WILLIAM.** Reg. No. 5849. Rank, Rifleman, Royal Irish Rifles, 2nd Batt.; killed in action, France, June 16, 1915; born Aughnacloy, Co. Tyrone.

**COTTER, WILLIAM.** Reg. No. 31515. Rank, Private, 2nd Royal Dublin Fusiliers; killed in action, France, October 18, 1918; born Maestag, Glamorganshire.

**COTTERILL, CLARENCE.** Reg. No. 28206. Rank, Private, Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers, 8th Batt.; died of wounds, France, April 29, 1916; born Sutton, Cheshire.

**COTTERILL, WILLIAM JOSEPH.** Reg. No. 43076. Rank, Corporal, 8th Royal Irish Fusiliers; died of wounds, France, September 8, 1916; born Marchington, Staffordshire.

**COTTIER, WALTER KANEEN.** Rank, 2nd Lieutenant, Liverpool Irish; died, August 23, 1918.

**COTTON, DANIEL.** Reg. No. 19738. Rank, Private, Royal Irish Fusiliers, 7 8th Batt.; died of wounds, France, May 10, 1917; born Stradbally, Queen's Co.

**COTTON, EDWARD.** Reg. No. 20216. Rank, Private, 1st Royal Dublin Fusiliers; died of wounds, France, April 26, 1917; born Lusk, Co. Dublin.

**COTTON, FRED.** Regimental No. 25157. Rank, Trooper, South Irish Horse; killed in action, Ypres, Belgium, February 22, 1918; born Ireland; age 20.

**COTTON, JOSEPH.** Reg. No. 15324. Rank, Private, 7th Leinster Regiment; killed in action, France, August 2, 1917; born Whitechurch, Salop.

**COTTON, LAWRENCE.** Reg. No. 7829. Rank, Rifleman, Royal Irish Rifles, 2nd Batt.; killed in action, France, April 26, 1916; born Wexford.

**COTTON, PHILIP.** Reg. No. 6746. Rank, Private, Royal Irish Regiment, 2nd Batt.; died, France, May 23, 1915; born St. Mary's, New Ross, Co. Wexford.

**COTTON, WILLIAM.** Reg. No. 9084. Rank, Private, 2nd Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers; killed in action, France, March 10, 1915; born Birmingham, Warwick.

**COTTRELL, ALBERT.** Reg. No. 12452. Rank, Acting Corporal, The Sherwood Foresters, 9th Batt.; killed in action, Gallipoli, August 9, 1915; born Dublin.

**COTTRELL, FRANK.** Reg. No. 21460. Rank, Private, 4th (Royal Irish) Dragoon Guards; killed in action, France, September 7, 1917; born Knutsford, Cheshire.

**COUBERY, JOHN JAMES.** Reg. No. 16739. Rank, Sergeant, 14th Royal Irish Rifles; killed in action, France, June 23, 1917; born Belfast.

**COUBROUGH, JAMES B.** Rank, Sergeant; killed in action, March 22, 1918.
