The Regiment was formed in 1881 from the 101st and 104th Regiments of Foot, which became the 1st and 2nd Battalions, respectively. The Regiment was allocated as its depot the military barracks at Tralee, Co. Kerry, and was as signed the counties of Kerry, Cork, Limerick and Clare as its recruiting area. In addition, the Regiment had a reserve battalions based in Tralee [3rd Battalion], Kinsale [4th Battalion] and Limerick [5th Battalion].

During the First World War, the Regiment was expanded by the addition of the 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th Battalions. During that war, the Regiment saw service in France, Gallipoli, the Balkans and Palestine and collected ten battle honours, including Gallipoli (2), Palestine (1) and France (7). The most well known of these engagements are Etreux [1914], "V" Beach, Gallipoli [1915], Aubers [1915], Guillemont [1916] and Ypres [1914-1917]. The Regiment was disbanded on 11th June, 1922.

This panel contains the names of 101 men who have been identified to date as having been killed while serving with the "Munsters."
